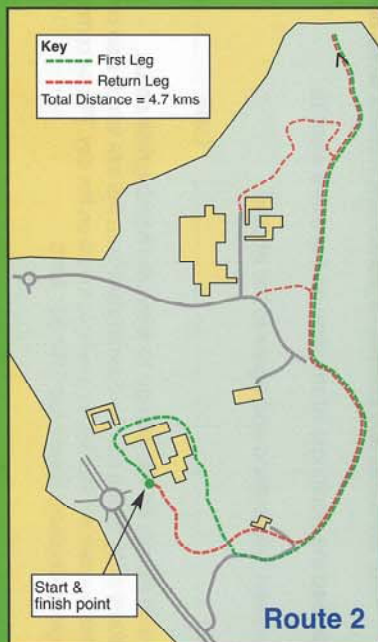

**Route 1: Big Ride - This route is approximately 25 miles (40k)**

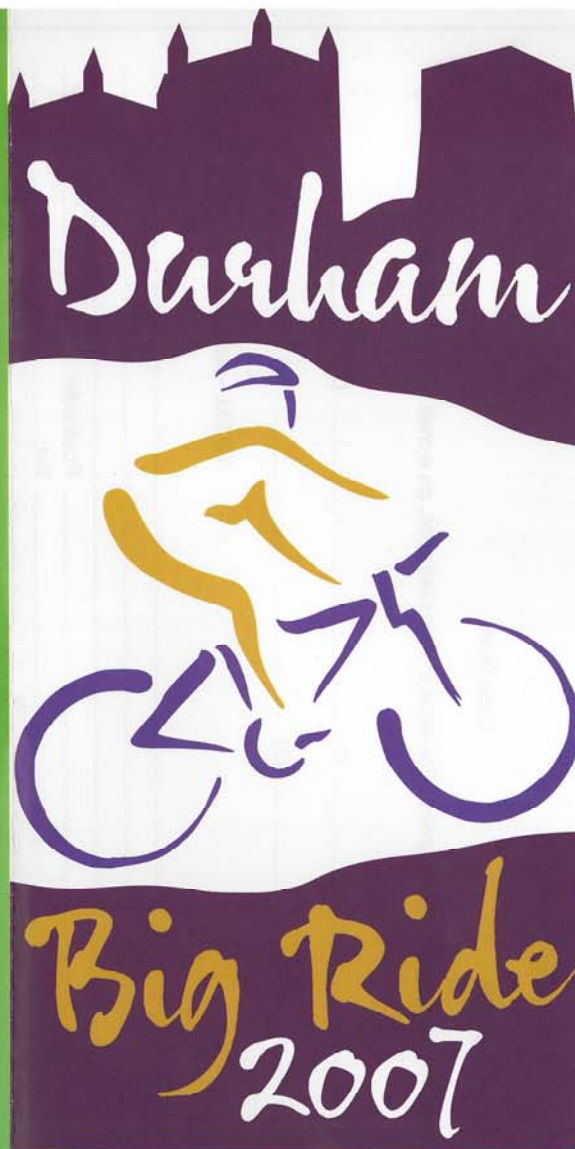
From Durham County Hall the route heads out of the City along the B6532 through Sacriston and then along minor roads towards Annfield Plain. The route skirts the south of Annfield Plain before turning generally westwards through wonderful countryside south of Leadgate to join the off-road Lanchester Valley Line Cycle route (NCN 14).

From there the meandering route will follow the cycle route towards the start at County Hall where participants can collect their commemorative 'T' shirts and goody bags, and enjoy the displays and activities.

**Route 2: Little Ride - This route is approximately 4.7 kms**

This is a gentle ride where children, cycle novices, the less able-bodied can take a gentle ride around the picturesque grounds of Aykley Heads.
